In an effort to do this we are currently addressing the Health and Safety of Employees and our Business Operations as outlined below:

Employee and Visitor Health and Safety

- Travel restrictions, guidelines, and recommendations – We have limited all non-essential business travel.
- Meetings – All meetings will be held virtually. Conference Rooms in the office have been closed.
- Remote Workforce – All workers able to continue their job requirements from home are required to do so. All support and sales calls and emails will continue to be answered as technology was already in place to be able to continue business as normal remotely.
- Senior Managers required to be in the office will rotate on an agreed schedule.
- All employees who must work in the office are required to take their temperature before coming to work and will stay home if a fever is detected.
- Face masks have been made available to all employees in the facility to wear when they cannot be distanced while performing certain job functions, or otherwise at their discretion during normal, distanced, working conditions
- We have installed multiple hand sanitizers within the office premises.
- We ensure frequent cleaning and sanitization of our workplaces.
- We have increased space between employees' workstations.
- With regards to visitors, a protocol has been put in place to require prior approval and ensure screening of potential visits to the facility. All visitors must adhere to the same safety procedures as employees.

Business Operations

- Genesys Aerosystems is an Essential and Critical Infrastructure workforce as we manufacture and repair critical avionics for aircraft which falls under the Transportation and Logistics section of [Guidance on the Essential Critical Infrastructure Workforce: Ensuring Community and National Resilience in COVID-19 Response Memo](#). Our customers also include Health Care professionals operating HEMS as well as Law Enforcement. Both of these also fall under the guidelines set forth.
- Genesys Aerosystems is continuing to make on time deliveries.
- We are continually communicating with and monitoring our critical suppliers as local, state and US restrictions are further implemented. .
- Our supply chain is virtually 100% US based.
- Our manufacturing facilities are designed to allow for continued production while meeting the health concerns for our employees.
- Our repair station is also designed to allow continued support while maintaining safe distances.
- Research and Development is expected to continue without interruption.
